### YOUR RIGHTS ABOUT ANIMALS

You have the right to:

- Live in a safe environment without fear of dangerous animals.
- Speak up if you see an animal being treated badly.
- *F* Adopt or rescue stray animals legally.
- F Refuse to join or watch cruel animal events.



### YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES TOWARDS ANIMALS

#### **Provide Food and Water**

- Feed animals every day.
- Give them clean drinking water.

#### **Give Shelter and Comfort**

• Keep them safe from rain, sun, and cold.

#### **Prevent Pain and Suffering**

- Never beat, overwork, or cause pain.
- Take sick animals to a veterinarian.

#### **Allow Natural Behaviors**

• Let animals move, play, and rest freely.

#### **Train Animals Kindly**

• Use gentle training methods. No violence. Stop Animal Cruelty When You Can

• Help if safe. Report abuse immediately.

### EXAMPLES OF ANIMAL CRUELTY (WHICH ARE ILLEGAL)

- Starving animalsBeating or burning animals
- Forcing animals to fight
- Overworking sick animals
- Slow, painful killing
- Tying up animals all day
